



Annual Competition Guidance for Judges

Recognised as a charity by HMRC Ref: XT33069

1. Scoring is normally marks out of 20 with half marks permitted.
2. Presentation, (mounting), could have a moderate but not major impact on scoring.
3. Image titles are principally for identification only and are not intended to have a significant impact on scoring.
4. Scoring of images should be on a consistent basis across all categories/ classes; i.e. as though they are all in the same category/ class.
5. Bacup Camera Club (BCC) will determine which entrants are eligible for 'New Member' awards and will determine the winners on the basis of the Judge's scores. In the event of a tie BCC will invite the judge to decide.
6. Eligibility of 'Image of Rossendale' and 'Image of Bacup' will be determined by BCC. The inclusion of these prints in the delivery to the judge indicates that they are eligible.
7. The 'Best Set of Projected Images' awards are based on the aggregate scores of the images submitted by each entrant. There is no intention for the images to display a consistent theme.
8. If the judge considers that any image should be disqualified he or she should mark it as normal but bring to the attention of the Exhibition Secretary the reason for potential disqualification.
